The Indian Epilepsy School provides delegates the chance to come together, discuss the latest developments in basic and clinical epileptology, and network with fellow researchers and renowned teachers in the field of epileptology. The scientific programme of the Indian Epilepsy School 2019 promises to be innovative and engaging, with a wide range of teaching, EEG and video sessions. In a continuation with the pattern of last year's school, the delegates will get to participate in group learning activities with direct supervision of mentoring faculties.

Highlights of Indian Epilepsy School 2019

Objective of Epilepsy School

The first Indian Epilepsy School was held at the Bolgaty Palace Hotel, Cochin in December 2012. Organized under the aegis of the Indian Academy of Neurology and the Indian Epilepsy Society, this has had a successful run every year thereafter. It aims to fill the knowledge gap in EEG and Epilepsy training in Neurology residency programs in the country. The recurring theme is a holistic update of theoretical knowledge and practical skills for dealing with various aspects of epilepsy targeting the neurology students and young neurologists.

- ❖ The fees will include accommodation on twin-sharing basis, all meals (inclusive of breakfast, lunch and dinner and high tea twice served only at the conference venue) and course handbook with softcopy of teaching modules on pen drive. (Any other meals or beverages ordered by the attendees will have to be paid for personally)

Once chosen, the delegates will be intimated so as to complete the registration process inclusive of payment within a stipulated time. Any delay will lead to cancellation of candidature.**
